KC Water is replacing about 1.5 miles of water mains on several streets in Northeast neighborhoods and two streets in the Northland, including at or near property you own or occupy at [property address].


How Will This Affect Me?

- Traffic lanes may be temporarily closed, but you will always have access to your property.
- Large equipment will create noise and dust, which will be controlled.
- Water service will be shut off for brief periods.
 You will get advance notice.
- If your water meter is inside, we will move it outside.
- We will restore the street, curbs, driveways and sidewalks. We will restore lawns during planting season.
