KC Water is replacing about 1.3 miles of break-prone water mains in several Midtown neighborhoods, including at or near property you own or occupy at [property address].

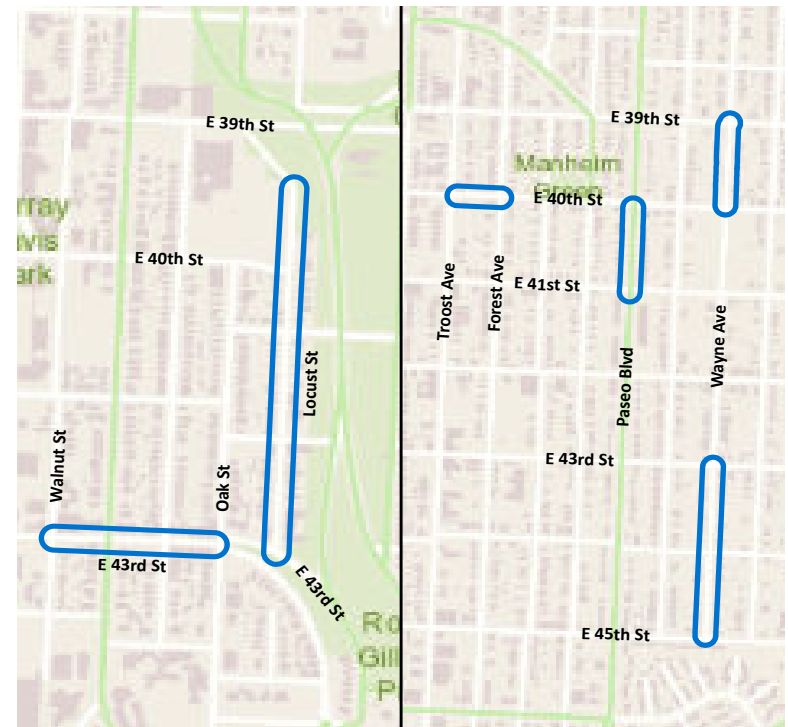
How Will This Affect Me?

- Traffic lanes may be temporarily closed, but you will always have access to your property.
- Large equipment will create noise and dust, which will be controlled.
- Water service will be shut off for brief periods. You will get advance notice.
- If your water meter is inside, we will move it outside.
- We will restore the street, curbs, driveways and sidewalks. We will restore lawns in season.
