
Milray Stoddard Storm Water Improvements Study Location




Todd Creek WWTP Site Map

Retrospective

- Initial public input was too late in the design process. Acknowledgment that it should have started much earlier.
- Revise public engagement guidance major facilities
- Department developing engagement standards and expectations



Environmental Concerns

North Site

- Phase 1 Environmental Report completed 2/23
 - No Phase 2 sampling recommended
- Omission discovered by community
 - 2020 "Notice and Order to Abate"
- Phase 2 Environmental Assessment will be completed

Southeast Site

Phase 1 Environmental
 Assessment will be completed if committee substitution passes followed by Phase 2 if recommended.



Geotechnical Concerns

North Site

- Previously surface mined
- Potential future subsurface mining
- Risk management steps will be implemented is if mining commences

South Site

- No geotechnical borings completed at this time
- Risk management steps will be established if mined



Delay Capital Improvement Plan Effects

- Todd Creek WWTP project is currently included in the FY24 WW CIP
- Site relocation will likely delay project to the FY26 CIP
- Evaluating offset of FY26 impacts
