NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND OPEN HOUSE

PROJECT: The Todd Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant was built in 1968 and expanded in 1990 but has exceeded its useful life due to Northland growth, the new KCI passenger terminal, and aging less efficient treatment technology. KC Water plans to construct a new plant to increase capacity, install new treatment technology, and accommodate future growth.

PURPOSE: In 2023, the project team had several meetings with citizens in the area about the location of the new treatment facility and listened to their concerns. An alternate location has been selected (see attached map), and the public is invited to an open house to learn about the new location and the project. The open house will be followed by a public meeting on the environmental impact of the project.
