

SPILL/ SLUG DISCHARGE NOTIFICATION

FOR INDUSTRIES DISCHARGING TO KCMO'S WASTEWATER SYSTEM



WHEN TO NOTIFY KC WATER

Notify KC Water if a spill, leak, slug discharge, accidental release, or other non-routine discharge reaches or may reach the sewer system.

HAVE THIS INFORMATION READY:

- Date/Time of incident
- Location of spill/discharge
- material involved
- Estimated concentration, if known
- Estimated Volume
- Estimated Duration
- Whether discharge is ongoing
- Known Hazards
- Corrective actions taken
- If the spill made it to the city system
