



# YOUR INVESTMENTS AT WORK

## FLOOD RISK MANAGEMENT PROJECT

In the Area of Prospect and Blue River Road to Bruce R. Watkins Drive

### WHAT

- Flood risk reduction infrastructure will be constructed to protect the Dodson Industrial Business District.
- A 20-ft tall earthen levee will be constructed to protect the area.
- The earthen levee will connect the existing upstream levee section and the existing downstream floodwall.
- Funding for this project is provided in part by bonds approved by Kansas City voters for flood control projects.

### WHY

- Phase V will complete this flood risk reduction project, which will protect the Dodson Industrial District from a storm with a 0.2% chance of occurring each year (500-year flood), or about a 6% chance of occurring in a 30-year span.

### WHEN

- Weather permitting, work will begin February 2018 and conclude June 2020.

### WHO

- KC Water in partnership with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and The Lane Construction Corporation

### IMPROVEMENTS

- Protecting existing development
- Enhancing area's future economic stability

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Large equipment will be used, creating noise and dusty conditions, which will be controlled.
- Lawns will be replaced with seed or sod, depending on the season, after work is completed.
- Ordinary travel routes may be temporarily restricted.
