

YOUR INVESTMENTS AT WORK

WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN EXTENSION

N. Brighton Avenue - Searcy Creek Parkway

WHAT?

- Important infrastructure work will be performed in your area.
- 36-inch water transmission main extension.

WHY?

- The new water main will extend water supply to enable future development and growth.

WHEN?

- Weather permitting, construction will begin November 2018 and conclude September 2019.

WHO?

KC Water in partnership with Kissick Construction Company, Inc.

WHERE?

The water transmission main runs through Pleasant Valley Park from NE 64th Street and N. Brighton Avenue to Pleasant Valley Road near Searcy Creek Parkway.

IMPROVEMENTS?

- Increased system reliability.
- Increased capacity for north system.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Large equipment will be used, creating noise and dusty conditions, which will be controlled.
- Road and street land closures will be clearly marked.
- Any curbs, driveways, and streets affected by this construction will be replaced.
- Lawn and wooded areas will be restored when work is complete.
