

## ACH ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS

Your Monthly Billing Statement Made Easy!

Here's how it works ...

ACH electronic bill payment is a service offered by KC Water in which pre-authorized electronic funds are automatically withdrawn from your checking account as payment for your monthly bill at no additional cost to you.

When your ACH electronic bill payment becomes active, you will continue to receive a statement from KC Water showing your usage, the amount due, and a notation reflecting your ACH bill payment participation.

On the due date shown on your bill we automatically deduct the amount of your bill from your bank account unless you contact us questioning the amount due, at least four days prior to this date.

Signing up for ACH electronic bill payment eliminates the need for mailing checks, buying stamps, or paying in person! And, best of all, you don't have to worry about missed payments or late fees!

Please complete the payment authorization form below, ATTACH A VOIDED CHECK (see below) for verification of bank account information, and return it to:
